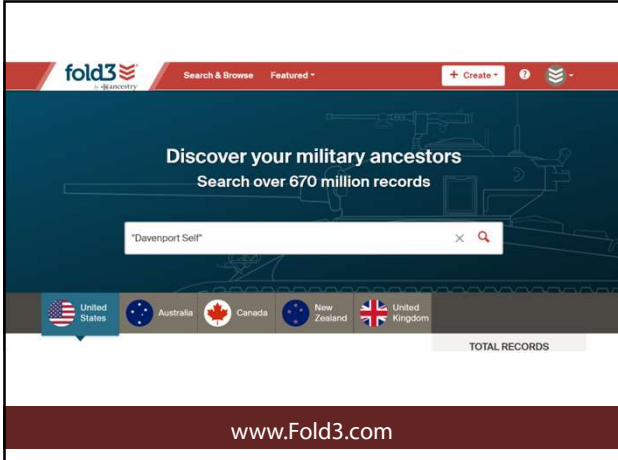

STATE OF *Kentucky* TOWN OF *Campbellburg*

I, *Davenport Self*, born _____ day of _____ 1827, in the State of *Kentucky*, aged _____ years, and by occupation a *Farmer*. Do hereby pledge to have volunteered this _____ day of *October*, 1864, to serve as a *Soldier* in the Army of the United States of America, for the period of *THREE YEARS*, unless sooner discharged by proper authority. Do also agree to accept each bounty, pay, rations, and clothing, as they may be established by law for volunteers. And I, *Davenport Self*, do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the **United States of America**, and that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whatsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles of War.

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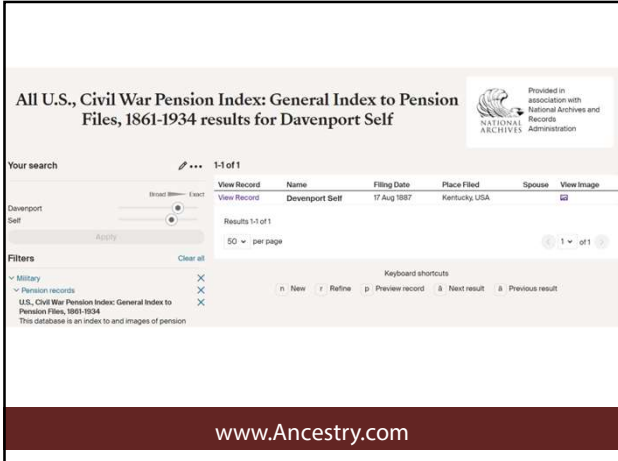
Civil War Pensions

- These files are typically not online and must be ordered from the National Archives

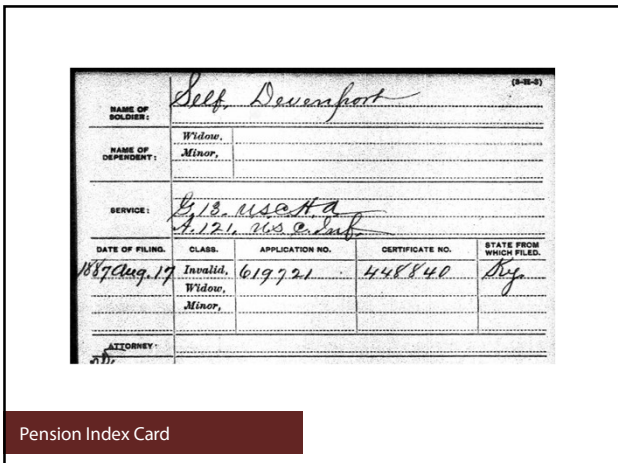
